

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MAJOR CROSS BORDER EXCHANGE CORRIDOR





- Remoteness
- > Underdeveloped infrastructure e.g. road and facility
- > Budget dependency on Central Government
- Insufficient Personnel for Customs, Immigration etc.
- > Unregulated Status of Transit Transportation
- Policy on Development of Major Mining Area is in Process
