- Base of linkage North East Asia to Europe through Siberia

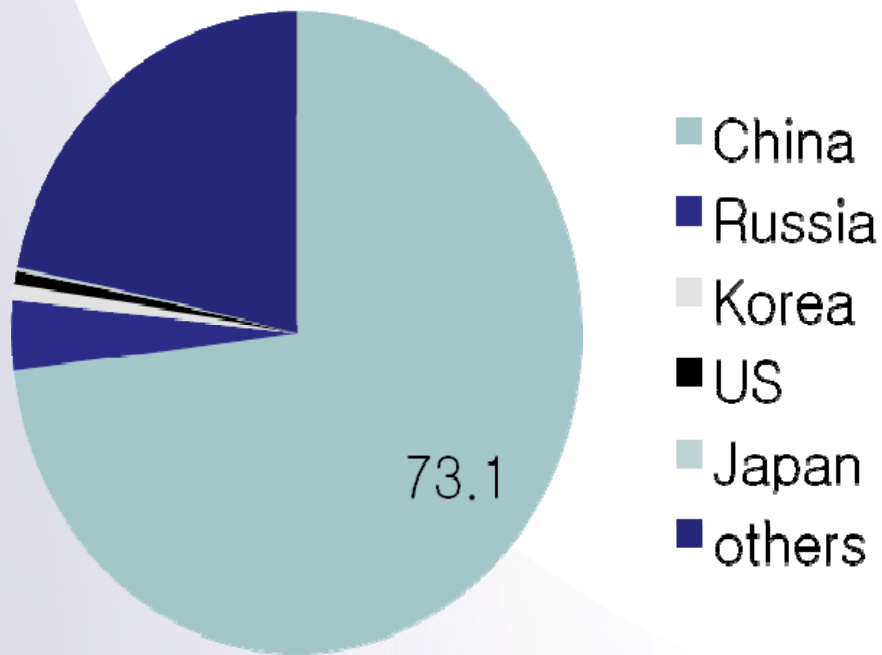
Multilateral Security

- Collaboration with North Korea

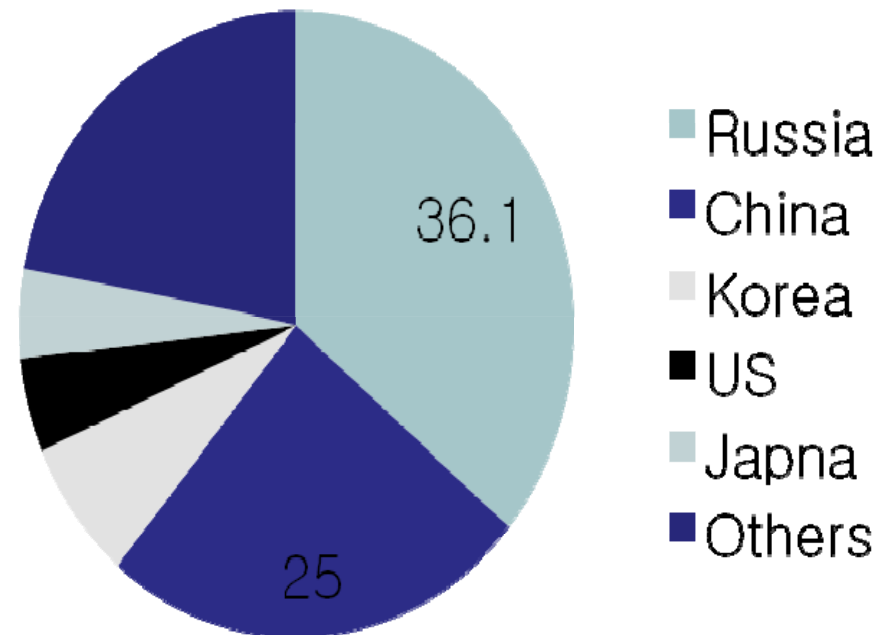
Trade

Import

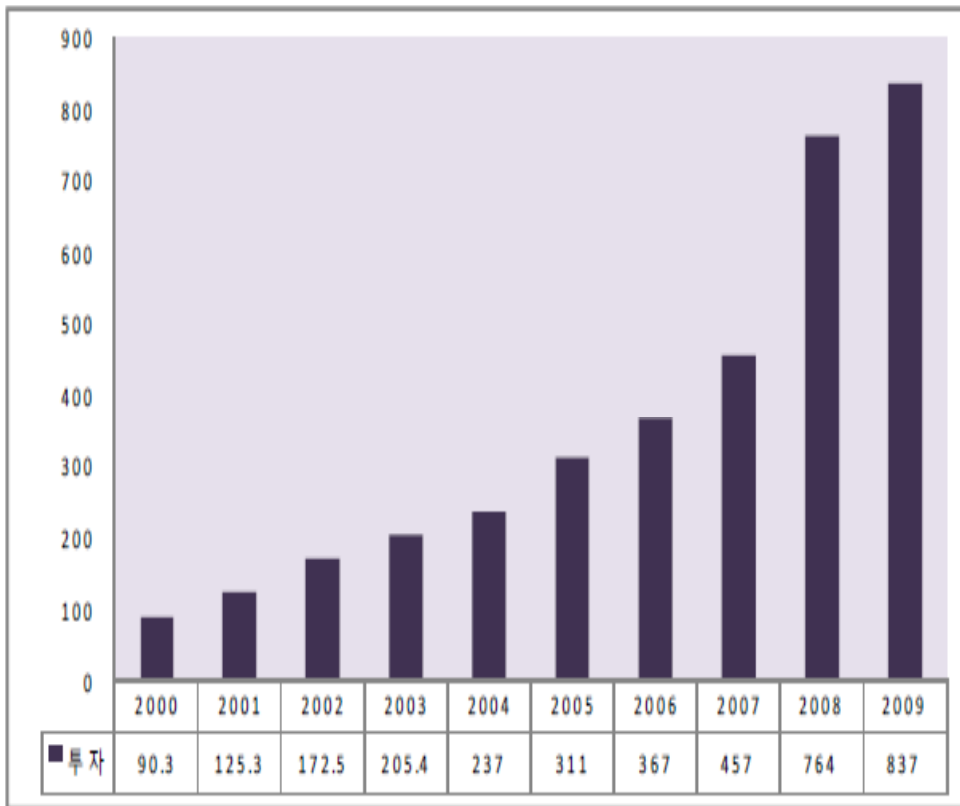


International Economic Cooperation of Mongolia

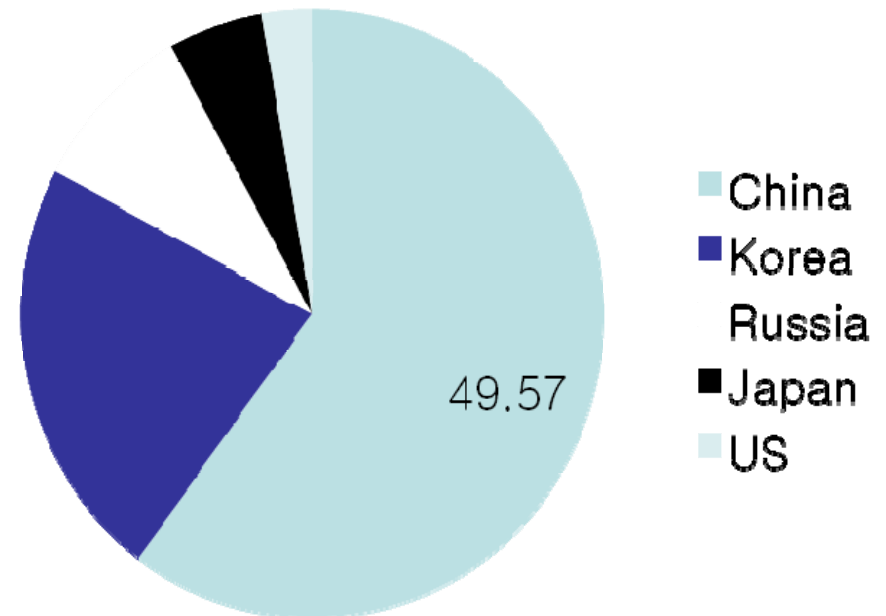
FDI
